The Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority's (SEPTA) Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Program, a component of its existing DBE Program, was developed in accordance with Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 26.39 – Fostering Small Business Participation. The basis for SBE certification is economic disadvantage and applies the same size limits (e.g., gross receipts and personal net worth) as DBE certification.
